Name Traces and CE Clearance for JANSONS, OZOLINS, RIEKSTINS

REFERENCE: MGM-A-6095 - *Redbird*

1. ID, EUCOM records indicate that on 7 February 1950 the French advised ID, EUCOM that one fnu OZOLINS, Latvian DP, is suspected of being a Soviet agent and requested all available information ID had regarding him. ID requested CIC traces on OZOLINS and was advised on 21 February 1950 that there were approximately seventy-five cards in Central Registry on fnu OZOLINS and that it was impossible to make a positive identification with the information submitted by the French.

2. ID, EUCOM files contain no record of the other individuals mentioned in reference.
